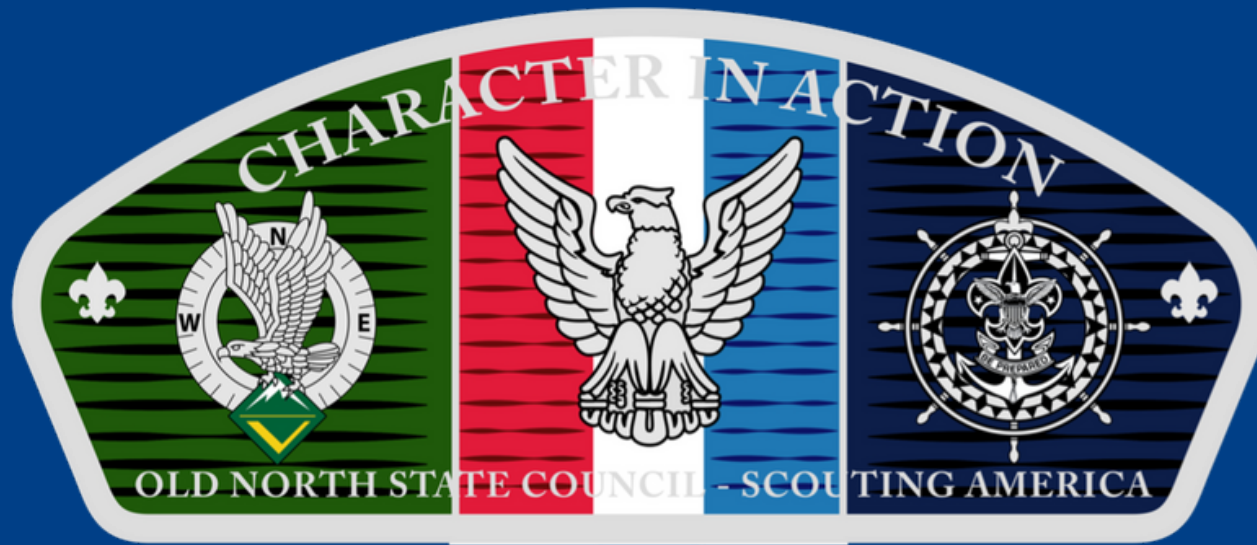

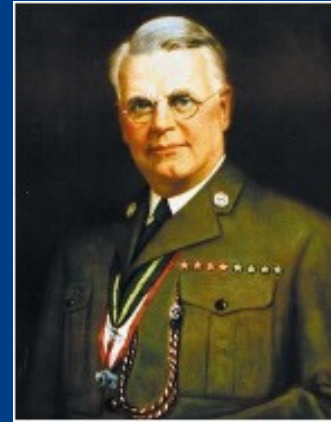

As part of the OA Induction process and NYLT syllabus, adult leaders are to walk through the open camping areas at unannounced times throughout the night of the Ordeal or NYLT patrol campout to provide roving supervision. Youth protection policies, including two deep leadership must be maintained during these walk-throughs.

3

The National Camp Accreditation Program (NCAP) requires all long-term and short-term camps to include a health officer on its emergency response team.

In 2016, the Boy Scouts of America established the Elbert K. William Benjamin Burns

Silver Beaver honoree William Burns' adult Scouting journey began in 2007 with Pack 16 at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in High Point as a Tiger Den leader. He continued to serve as a den leader with pack for 5 years and then transitioned to Troop 26 as an Assistant Scout Master in 2012.

In 2014 he was inducted into the Order of the Arrow and in 2016 he moved into Troop 26's Committee Chair position

William became a unit commissioner in 2019 and took over as the Akela District Commissioner in 2021 and currently serves in that position. While as a commissioner he earned the Arrowhead award and has completed bachelor's, master's and first year doctorate commissioner of science training.

In 2023, he was awarded the Distinguished Commissioner Award of Excellence and Commissioner Key.

In 2022 he joined the Old North State fishing committee and received his Certified Angler Instructor (CAI) certification in 2023. William plays a key role in planning and executing the council-wide Cub Scout fishing derby designed to recruit new Cub Scouts. He is also an instructor for the CAI course and helping plan a deep sea fishing training opportunity for Scout leaders.

In 2024 he received the District Award of Merit and has assisted with the planning of the past four Akela & Uwharrie district merit badge colleges where he has also been teaching for the last 15 years.

William is also a proud Beaver of the Wood Badge course SR-70-16, and along with his wife Kim and two Eagle Scout sons Paul and Joseph, they continue to help the scouting program by volunteering at various events in the district.

He is a Vigil Honor member of the Order of the Arrow. He also received the Order of the Arrow Founder's Award. He was awarded the James E. West Fellowship for his service to the Order of the Arrow and Cherokee Scout Reservation. He is a member of the Cherokee Scout Reservation Hall of Leadership.

Andrew served on the Cherokee Scout Reservation camp staff from 2011-2023. In 2016, Andrew joined the Old North State Camping Committee where he serves as the Welding Merit Badge program adviser. In this role he champions the welding program at summer camp developing lesson plans, identifying the best equipment and materials, and training the camp staff so they can teach the merit badge safety and fully.

He developed and leads the Winnie the Welder event – a Welding Merit Badge opportunity for Scouts BSA girls. In addition to learning the skills associated with Welding Merit Badges, the Scouts learn how women filled the country's need for welders when the men left to fight World War II.

Andrew is an active member of the Golden Beavers – a group of volunteers who volunteer weekly at Cherokee Scout Reservation to assist with maintenance.

While Andrew volunteers on Fridays and not the typical Tuesday, he is faithful in his commitment to ensure camp is safe and prepared to deliver a quality program. Cherokee benefits from his skill as welder, machinist, and builder.

When not supporting the rangers at Cherokee, Andrew can be found in the kitchen. He is an outstanding cook and regularly serves as the head cook for training and OA events.

Andrew has served on the National Jamboree staff. He is Wood Badge trained and preparing to serve on his second Wood Badge staff. He is a member of the National Camp Assement Program (NCAP) visitation team.

In high school, Andrew earned his welding certificate which heavily influenced his decision to choose welding as a career. Andrew works for Versalift as a traveling welder.

Rusty's experience in Scouting as a young person sparked his interest in healthcare and service to others. Volunteering as a member of the Madison-Rockingham Rescue Squad since 1997 he quickly took on leadership roles and served as Chief from 2005-2022. He was Squad Member of the year in 1999, 2000, & 2010 and became an Honorary Life Member in 2017.

Rusty has worked for Cone Health at the CareLink Critical Care Transport Team for 23 years. Rusty has served as the Lead EMT and Fleet Manager since 2014. Rusty was the Cone Health Employee of the Month in December 2013 & June 2018. He received the City of Lynchburg, VA Distinguished Service Award for Life Saving in 2014 after quickly jumping into action to save a person life in an automobile accident. In his spare time, he can be found cutting meat at Bi-Rite in Stokesdale.
